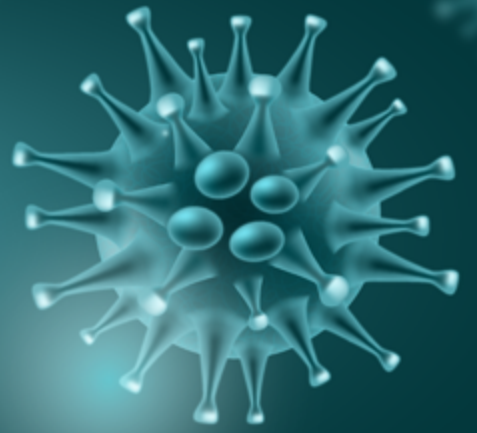


CONVENING SAFELY



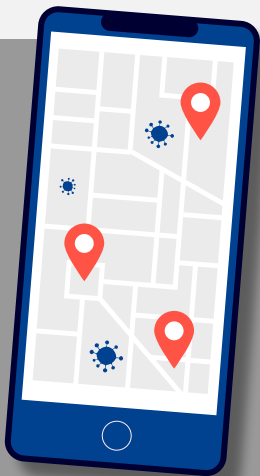
For those enjoying the in person experience of the **NEXT** Convention taking place next weekend, we want you to know that we have your safety in mind. We are taking precautions as laid out by the Events Safety Council:

KEEPING ATTENDEES SAFE

We have started by keeping the attendee numbers low by only opening up an exclusive amount of tickets for the event, of which there are still a few available. This keeps our number in the "Very Low Risk" level. With further steps being taken to keep all attendees safe.

SEATING ARRANGEMENTS

The seating area will be arranged with seats apart from one another at their own tables with power supply points at each table. Allowing you to charge your devices and use your laptop for making notes.



CONTACT TRACING APP

We will be recommending all attendees and staff to install the Contact tracing app, this is to ensure if anyone is exposed over the convention they can be informed and can take the necessary precautions.

SYMPTOMS

A reminder of the symptoms, according to the World Health Organisation (WHO) the common signs of infection include:

- Mild to severe respiratory symptoms
- Fever

- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhoea
